POSITION SUMMARY:

The Youth Pastor is a full-time staff member who is responsible for providing leadership, mentorship, discipleship, shepherding, and creativity for our youth ministry (Grades 4-12) at Princeton Baptist Church. This position involves overseeing both our Jr. High and Sr. High ministries, including the ability to engage and motivate others, work with youth and leaders, and ultimately help lead youth to become authentic followers of lesus.

ACCOUNTABILITY:

The Youth Pastor is supervised by and reports to the Lead Pastor.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

A. Duties:

- 1. Implement the vision and values of PBC in our youth ministry.
- 2. Develop and implement strategies to reach and disciple youth Jr. High and Sr. High students and their families in our community and share the Gospel with them.
- 3. Provide leadership in discipling and mentoring youth through various means.

4. Develop and implement strategies to integrate youth and their families into the life, work, and worship of our church body.

B. Expectation of Duties:

I. Spiritual Leadership:

- Prepare and facilitate effective youth ministry events that build community and allow faith to be shared in a safe environment.
- Encourage youth to grow in faith through activities and discipleship relationships.
- Teaching and discipling youth in Biblical and Spiritual leadership through the truths of the Bible
- Develop and implement strategies to integrate newcomers into our youth ministry and into worship and life of the congregation; encourage youth to actively participate in the ministries of the church.
- Willing to lead short-term mission experiences for youth, both local and global.
- Willing to engage with youth in missional community.

II. Administration:
